### **RAIN OUTS**

Summer weather is unpredictable. It maybe raining at your house but be sunny at the field— or vice versa.

**Please check your email or call the WAA Weather Hotline (419-0833) before leaving for a game. Cancellations are made on a field-by-field basis.** The league will do everything possible to prevent unnecessary trips and keep your family safe.

### **RAIN PRIOR TO THE GAME**

If the field is unplayable, all games for that day will be called off and made up at a later date.

### **RAIN DURING THE GAME**

If it is raining so hard that the field will be unplayable then the game and any game(s) immediately following will be canceled. We'll try and wait out "sprinkles". The decision to call or continue a game will be made by the umpire. Both coaches will email the league that a cancellation took place.

### **THUNDER OR LIGHTNING DURING THE GAME**

At the first sign of thunder or lightning we will have a 20-minute waiting period before play can resume. The game will be called if the 20 minutes is longer than the time left to play. A second instance of thunder or lightning signals a restart of the 20-minute waiting period. The decision to begin a waiting period, call or continue a game will be made by the umpire. Both coaches will email the league that a cancellation took place.

### **MAKE-UP GAMES**

Games will be declared incomplete if less than 45 minutes of play has occurred and if full innings have not been played and all players have not batted once. We'll try and make-up games that week or add them to the end of the season as needed.
